Safety and Events Committee

Terms of Reference

Mandate

Hosting events and providing a safe environment for all rowers, coaches, officials and volunteers is a foundation for the success of Row Nova Scotia. The Safety and Events Committee supports the Board of Row Nova Scotia by enabling our members and clubs to develop excellence in all aspects of rowing in a competitive and safe environment across Nova Scotia.

Composition

The Safety and Events Committee is chaired by a Row Nova Scotia Board Member and includes Row Nova Scotia's Administrative Representative and a minimum of two members at large. The committee members shall be appointed by the Row Nova Scotia Board of Directors and serve a one-year term with the ability for re-election. The time commitment of this committee is approximately 4-8 hours per month.

Responsibilities

The primary responsibilities of the Safety and Events Committee include, but are not limited to:

- facilitating and organizing the hosting of events that cater to all levels of rowers, coaches, umpires and volunteers;
- providing leadership on the education and regulation of safety matters involved with the sport of rowing; and
- ensuring events provide high quality opportunities for development of all levels of rowers, coaches, umpires and volunteers.
