Coach and Umpire Education Committee

Terms of Reference

Mandate

Coach and umpire education is a foundation for the success of Row Nova Scotia. The Coach and Umpire Education Committee supports the Board of Row Nova Scotia by focusing on the development and sustainability of coaches and umpires across Nova Scotia.

Composition

The Coach and Umpire Education Committee is chaired by a Row Nova Scotia Board Member and includes Row Nova Scotia's Administrative Representative and a minimum of one member at large. The committee members will be elected by the Row Nova Scotia Board of Directors and serve a one-year term with the ability for re-election. The time commitment of this committee is approximately 4-8 hours per month.

Responsibilities

The primary responsibilities of the Coach and Umpire Education Committee include, but are not limited to:

- facilitate the development of coaches and umpires in Nova Scotia at all levels;
- provide opportunities for coach and umpire education through workshops and professional development; and
- explore opportunities for funding and further support for Nova Scotia coaches and umpires.
