## **Community Engagement Committee**

### **Terms of Reference**

#### **Mandate**

Community engagement is a foundation for the success of Row Nova Scotia's growth and long term sustainability. The Community Engagement Committee supports the Board of Row Nova Scotia by increasing positive awareness of the sport of rowing through various communications efforts, fundraising initiatives, and membership support.

#### **Composition**

The Community Engagement Committee is chaired by a Row Nova Scotia Board Member and includes Row Nova Scotia's Administrative Representative and a minimum of two members at large. The committee members shall be appointed by the Row Nova Scotia Board of Directors and serve a one-year term with the ability for re-election. The time commitment of this committee is approximately 4-8 hours per month.

#### **Responsibilities**

The primary responsibilities of the Community Engagement Committee include, but are not limited to:

- building positive awareness of Row Nova Scotia and the sport of rowing among members and the external community through various outreach and communication activities;
- representing and advocating for funding to support various initiatives;
- providing meaningful engagement opportunities for members; and
- working collaboratively with clubs on community engagement goals set by the strategic plan of Row Nova Scotia.
